




House at Work Tour | Major Grant Announcement | Rosé Garden Party

Lippitt House Museum's Civics Program for English Language Learners Gets Major Boost



Lippitt House Museum is proud to announce that it is one of only eight public projects in the state to be awarded a 2024 major grant from the Rhode Island Council for the Humanities. This grant will support the Museum's Civics Program, a series of civics lessons and field trips for adult English speakers of other languages studying for the United States Citizenship & Immigrant Services Civics exam. This enables the Museum to refine and expand its existing civics programming developed with classes at RI Family Literacy Initiative, Dorcas International, and Genesis Center.

Exciting new components will be a Civics Celebration Open House for the public and a video sharing immigrants' stories about their journeys to Rhode Island and paths towards citizenship, both in 2025. Stay tuned!
